Carl Bagnini, LCSW received his MSW from New York University, and holds certificates in Family Therapy from the Long Island Institute for Psychoanalysis and Psychotherapy and the Ackerman Institute for the Family. He was Assistant Director of the Family Therapy Training Program at LIIPP. He teaches Advancements in Object Relations Couple Therapy and supervises at the Adelphi University Derner Institute Postgraduate Program in Marital and Couple Therapy, and is on faculty at the Contemporary Institute of Integrative Psychoanalysis & Psychotherapy in Tampa, FL. He is chair of The National Program on Child, Couple and Family Therapy of the International Institute of Object Relations Therapy, in Washington, DC, and is chair of the Long Island Satellite Teaching Program in Port Washington, NY where he teaches and supervises candidates in two certificate programs. Carl has presented in monthly video-link teaching seminars with invited faculty, including David Scharff, MD, Otto Kernberg, MD, and Glen Gabbard, MD, in London, Panama, Salt Lake City, Utah, Washington, DC, and Port Washington, NY. He has authored and co-authored 12 book chapters and several papers in the U.S and Italy and is working on a book: Working With Couples: Inside and Out. He has presented in London, England, The Republic of Panama, Edinburgh, Scotland, and regularly teaches in Washington, DC. He is in private practice in Port Washington, NY.
